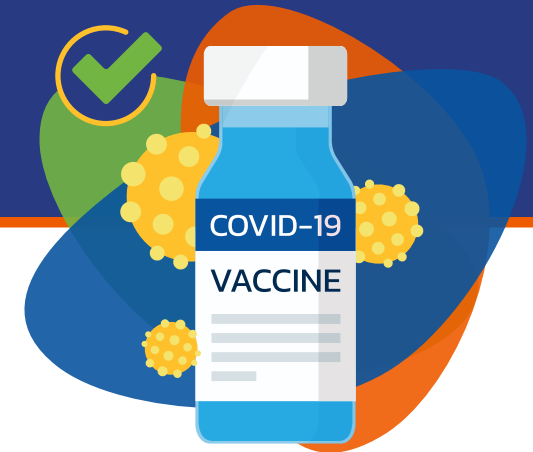

Up to 2.354M doses
